

Company Policy Environmental

Policy Statement

Absolute Calibration are conscious of the effect its business activities have on the environment and are committed to protect the environment and not cause any pollution. With this in mind all activities performed within the Company have been assessed for their environmental impact. Where possible all efforts have been made to ensure that the processes have the smallest possible environmental impact and that waste is recycled where possible and disposed of in accordance with current legislation.

The Company uses the services of other calibration laboratories and manufacturers or their agents to carry out work on its behalf. It is Company policy to use, wherever possible environmentally aware companies. All companies are expected to ensure that their activities have minimal impact on the environment.

The Company performs calibration work at customers' premises. All environmental aspects identified are controlled in the same manner at the customers' site as they are at our facility. Onsite engineers are expected to conduct their activities in accordance with this policy or the policies of that customer's site and not cause unnecessary environmental impact.

The Company does not have any manufacturing processes. It has identified and evaluated the environmental aspects that could have an effect on the environment, and have categorised them as *Internal* - waste generate, end of life waste and services used, electricity, water and gas; and *External* - inbound deliveries and subcontracted services; with both having legislative and regulatory considerations. The Company will ensure the responsible use of natural resources and the control and minimisation of waste and energy consumption. Environmental objectives have been set against each impact and are included on the environmental Aspects form.

Responsibilities

The person responsible for the environmental issues of the Company is the Managing Director and the Quality Director is his deputy. They will ensure that adequate resource is available for the implementation and continual improvement, where possible, of the environmental management system.

Contribution

Each staff member of the Company must take responsibility for adherence to the environmental manual and procedures, and must work with the Company's stakeholders in order that the Company can achieve its environmental aims and ensure its compliance obligations.

This Policy will be reviewed in-line with the Company's quality management system and/or when a new service is offered, highlighted through contract review.
